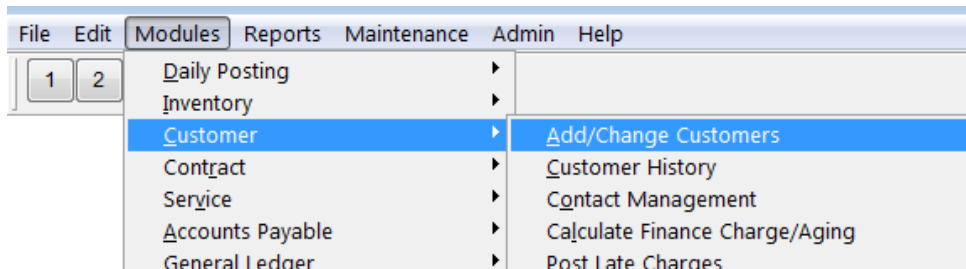


# CR900 Drivers License Barcode Scanner

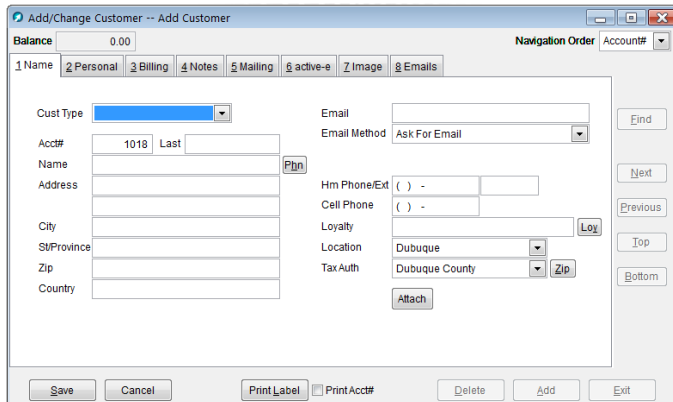
The CR900 is designed to scan UPC, EAN, Code 39/128, and 2D barcodes on a driver's license.

To scan a barcode do the following:

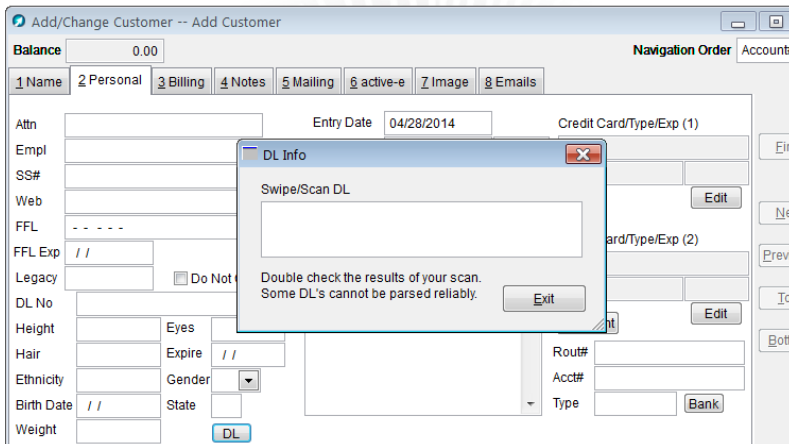
- 1) Go to Add/Change Customers.



- 2) If you are adding a new customer click Add. If you are editing an existing customer click Find then select the appropriate customer. Fill out the "Customer Type" and any information you would like to add or change for the customer.



- 3) Click the Personal tab and then click the DL button. Scan in the driver's license using the CR900.



- 4) Once the scan is complete AIMsi automatically populates any fields that are compatible for AIMsi and the state license. Depending on the state, these include: DL No, Height, Eyes, Hair, Expire, Ethnicity, Gender, Birth Date, State, and Weight.

**Note: All fields may not be compatible to auto-populate.**

*To also populate name and address information using the scanned driver's license, set up this optional system variable:*

CustomerDLAddress (under *Maintenance > General Maintenance > System Variables*)

This two-position Y|N variable determines if name and address information from a scanned driver's license automatically populates corresponding fields on the Add/Change Customer window. Each position is separated by the pipe (|) character.

- Position 1 determines if name and address information auto-populates when adding a new customer.
- Position 2 determines if name and address information auto-populates when editing an existing customer record.

For example, Y|N will populate the name and address information for new customers but not for existing customers.
